# THE JUNE 29, 2021, MASSACRE



**Armed Forces Brutality**

**People Injured**

The June 29 massacre saw over 500 men and women injured and hospitalized. Some of them lost their limbs and need wheelchairs and prosthetic rehabilitation.



**Atrocities on Women**

**Thrown in Fire**

Evidence of women thrown in the fire and some carrying children were some of the atrocities. The UED is assisting a woman that survived the burning in June 2021.



**People Maimed**

**Live Bullets Shot**

Activists were shot at with live bullets leading to many walking with bullets in their bodies. One of the famous incidents is when police threw teargas in a bus full of teachers and shooting at those jumping out through windows.



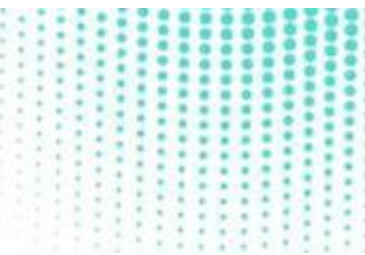
**People Massacred**

**About a 100 killed**

In June 2021 many young people were killed, and funerals held in different parts of Eswatini. Families were left destitute.

The brutality of the State was a direct result of the people calling for democratic changes from June 2021 culminating in the June 29 Massacre. Since 1973, the monarchy has usurped power from Swazis.

### Political Prisoners Support

Facilitate women and youth empowerment programs

Article 6 of the United Eswatini Diaspora constitution provides that any person or institution is eligible for membership provided that an application form is submitted by which the person signing shall, on his or her behalf or on behalf of the organization which they represent.

In essence, all Eswatini in the diaspora are eligible to be members of the movement and they shall be bound together by the principles of unity and unity of purpose. The UED has a constitution and policies that guide the operations of the organization, and the sole purpose is to support the struggle for freedom and human rights in Eswatini.
